      - It is inconsistent with CTE
      - Dr. Smith found out that there should be an ag science pathway and working with Jerry Sever
      - Default tests will be Workplace Readiness Assessment for the capstone assessment
      - Looked up Program Standards on the CTE website
    - Encourage use of Communities of Practice
    - Add Ag 120 to all pathways
      - Think this has been done
    - Replace Ag 514 for Horticulture Capstone
    - Use different IC code if it is for a non-Capstone course

- Create a sub-committee to advertise, encourage and plan the Ideas Unlimited Roundtable for June 2018
            - Volunteer will probably need to print out rubrics, judging, organizing, maybe work with the awards committee (maybe need to have this be split with the awards committee)

    - Review Ag Pathways identified by the CTE Division and make recommendations for courses in pathways
      - List questions that can be moved to the CTE division regarding pathways/clusters
        - Is this a creation of the Program of Study that we already have created?
        - Would it just be a different code if it is pathway or cluster?
        - Can I teach a class that is not in my pathway?
        - What tests do they want us to take? WRA? TSA?
        - What is the benefit of the WRA based on the test scores?
        - How can we make the pathways take into consideration the needs of the students and the communities?
        - Why can the teachers not develop the TSA?
      - Recommendations
        - Nevada and Utah have great pathways to model after
  - Curriculum Development Project Update- 130 and 530 (writing team or Dr. Smith)
    - Wanted to have 2 curriculums ready by this point
      - Teachers have been identified and have been working on those
      - Ongoing process
      - Fall should be ready to go by fall and should be ready for peer review
      - Most of 530 is going to be project based and will be complete with worksheets and materials lists
      - Shannon Blickenstaff is going to make sure that all the lesson plans are in the same format with objectives, interest approaches, wrap ups, etc.
      - Looking for beginning Ag Mech 130 class projects
      - Animal Science Writers are still needed in areas include
    - Which courses need help with getting developed
      - Intro to Livestock
        - something other than just livestock, less of evaluation and more of the basics of animal sciences
          - leads into the next class a little more
        - More by industry than by concept
      - Top ranked classes that need help
        - Botany Plant and Soils 510
          - And 512 and 514 all share a lot of labs and standards
        - Animal Nutrition 535
        - Intro to Ag 110
        - Intro to Ag Industry 120
        - Fish and Wildlife Sciences 536

- Dr. Smith will be making a comprehensive list of numbers of schools that teach Animal Nutrition and Fish and wildlife
- Recommend teacher writing team for Ag Leadership and Communications standards on July 31 at State CTE in Boise
  - Need people good in the content that are available for the conference
